<b>ITEM 4.2 - MATCH OFFICIALS (REFEREES) ELIGIBILITY</b>										
4.2.1	<p>Nominated Referees must be registered and participating with your Regional Association for eligibility and Insurance purposes, having regularly officiated at the local affiliated association in the current and/or previous Season.</p> <p>In order to conduct a state event, a suitable number of Match Officials (Referees) with appropriate qualifications are required. Nominations are sourced from Affiliates/ Teams in association with the relevant referee’s structure, promoting pathways and development opportunities.</p>									
4.2.2	<p><b>Badge Accreditation</b></p> <p>In order to conduct a quality State Event, all attending Match Officials must hold a TFA Referee Accreditation of Level 1-6 and be a <u>minimum</u> age of 12 yrs of age.</p>

These will be deemed indicative until the associated and required Match Officials are registered and confirmed.</p> <p>A Regional Association can nominate up to one (1) team per division. If a division is not filled, the host region will get the opportunity firstly to fill a vacant spot with a second team. Should the host region not be able to field a second team for the division, application can be made by the remaining regions.</p> <p>If a Regional Association wishes to nominate more than one (1) team in a division, they must send a written request to QTF.</p> <p>If any of the deadlines are not met, teams will only be accepted to enter the tournament as determined by QTF.</p> <p><b>Note:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A Region / Team Nomination is not complete until the required Match Officials nominations are received.</li> <li>• Region must confirm intent to use Tents at the point of the indicative Team Nomination.</li> </ul>

<p>6.2.1</p>	<p>A player must have played a minimum of one (1) round game to be eligible for the final series.</p> <p>Any player/s not fulfilling the criteria due to extenuating circumstances must make written application to the Event Manager for consideration.</p>

<p>6.3.1</p>	<p>After the close of nominations, an indicative draw will be distributed.</p> <p>The draft draw will only be distributed after team lists have been submitted and all nomination fees have been paid with required referee quota’s achieved.</p>

<b>ITEM 6.4 - PLAYING TIMES</b>	
6.4.1	<p>All games in the tournament will be 20 minutes each way with a half time break not exceeding five (5) minutes. However please note; these times may vary and are TBC (depending on team nominations).</p> <p>QTF Tournament Management reserves the right to amend the duration of games based on any specific requirements and in the best interests of completing the event with maximum participation.</p> <p><b>Note:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● All finals games must result in an outright winner. In the event of a drawn match at the end of full-time, a drop-off will determine the match winner.</li> </ul>
6.4.2	<p>The TFA standard <b>drop off</b> system will apply:</p> <p>After regulation time, when a defending team who has had previous possession knocks the ball down, the touch count will re-start rather than the game ending at that point. In this instance, the attacking team has not lost possession and therefore play should continue.</p>
6.4.3	<p>There is no 'time off' for serious injury during any Round Matches or Finals.</p>
