

POLICY ON PARTICIPATION IN UNAFFILIATED COMPETITIONS

QTF By-Law 4.35

“Persons who participate in unaffiliated Touch competitions without QTF Authority are ineligible to participate in Queensland controlled Championships, courses or any other event for a period of twelve months from the time of infringement”.

Under this QTF policy, with effect from Friday 29 October 1999, any person who participates in an unaffiliated competition will be required to show cause why they should not be disqualified from QTF events and courses for a period of 12 months. If in the opinion of QTF, the person is not able to show cause they will be subject to disqualification. In the case of 1999 representative players and officials, this disqualification will mean removal from the State squad.

Should a participant be removed from a State squad under this policy there will be no refund of State levies paid.

The requirements of this policy will be included in future State Player Agreements, and will be incorporated in QTF State Selection Policy.

Regions are strongly encouraged to incorporate these policy requirements in the process for Regional Selection.
