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<b>1.4.2</b>	<p><b>Proof of Age</b></p> <p>Acceptable documentation includes Birth Certificate, current Passport, current School Identification and/or Driver’s License.</p> <p>It is the responsibility of the Affiliate Coordinator (Tour Leader) to ensure all players meet the age requirements to play in the particular division. Failure to provide such evidence may result in disqualification from the event.</p> <p><b>Note:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>› Male players can only be nominated for male divisions and female players vice versa.</li> <li>› Players are only permitted to participate in one division at the event unless otherwise approved by Tournament Management. 1.5.1	<p>Match Officials details must be submitted as part of the team nominations process which is due <b>Wednesday 24 April 2019</b>.</p> <p>Once the Team completes the online nomination form (with Match Officials details included), an individual registration link will be sent to the referee intending to come to Junior State Cup.</p> <p>The Referee must then complete the individual Registration Link by <b>Wednesday 29 May 2019</b>.</p>
1.5.2	<p>Affiliate Coordinator (Tour Leader) responsibilities:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>› A minimum of 1 Match Official per team by <b>05:00 PM Wednesday 24 April 2019</b>.</li> <li>› Nominated Match Officials must be officiating at the Affiliate they wish to represent.</li> <li>› Nominated Match Officials must be of the required standard and qualification.</li> <li>› Nominated Match Officials must be able to be in attendance for all 3 days of competition and attend all required Meetings.</li> </ul>
1.5.3	<p><b>Referee Coaching</b></p> <p>Match Officials must apply via the online registration, to receive Coaching from one of the attending QTF Referee Panel during the event.</p>

## SECTION 2: TOURNAMENT CHECK-IN & FINAL ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

<b>2.1</b>	<p>QTF will conduct a Tournament Check-in. The Tournament Check-In is for Affiliate Coordinators and/or Team Managers to submit their Final Team Sheets in hard copy and/or collect their team match ball.</p> <p><b>Check-In Details</b></p> <p>Time: 04:30 PM – 06:30 PM (see 1.1.3 for specific timings)</p> <p>Venue: Beach House Hotel, the Esplanade Hervey Bay, QLD</p>
<b>2.2</b>	<p><b>Team Sheets</b></p> <p>A Team Sheet (online through Sports TG) must be completed correctly with the following information:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>› Player Number</li><li>› Player Details (Name, Phone, Email, Guardian Details)</li><li>› Management Details (Coach, Assistant Coach, Manager)</li></ul> <p>The Affiliate Coordinator/ Team Manager must update their final team shirt numbers into inferno Sports TG prior to <b>05:00 PM on Friday 05 July 2019</b>. They must advise the event manager, once this has occurred via <a href="mailto:rachael@qldtouch.com.au">rachael@qldtouch.com.au</a></p> <p><b>Note:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>› Team Managers will need to sign off team sheets at the Tournament Check-In. It will be the team managers responsibility to ensure all team numbers and names are correct.</li></ul>
<b>2.3</b>	<p><b>Information Pack</b></p> <p>Additionally, an information pack will be available for download prior to the event for all Affiliate Coordinators/ Team Managers and/or Coaches, players and parents.</p> <p>No responsibility will be taken for any actions undertaken by management staff who do not read all necessary material.</p> <p>This will be available via the <a href="http://www.qldtouch.com.au">www.qldtouch.com.au</a> website and Junior State Cup app.</p>
<b>2.4</b>	<p>Affiliate Coordinators must complete the Team &amp; Match Officials nominations for the selected affiliate. Nominations individually made a coach or manager will not be accepted.</p> <p>Affiliate Coordinators must provide accurate and up to date contact details for themselves, individual Team Managers/ Coaches and Match Officials at the point of nomination. This is vital to ensure all information is passed on to the relevant individuals involved.</p>





**2.5** It is the responsibility of the Affiliate Coordinators (Tour Leader) to ensure all teams and match officials are informed of any changes when notified by QTF and that they have read and clearly understood all requirements.

### SECTION 3: ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

#### Item 3.1 – PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

**3.1.1** Must be an active registered player (registered into the Touch Football Online database), participating and financial member with an Affiliated Association.

All players must have played a minimum of five (5) games:

- > In the one team
- > In the one division
- > In the one competition
- > In the same season; and
- > Within the Affiliate the player wishes to play for.

**Note:**

- > The minimum standard for QTF is that of a weekly competition running no less than ten (10) weeks based on one (1) round per week. Finals are in addition to this.

Therefore, competitions which are shorter than 10 weeks will not be considered such as, but not limited to; Ipswich Super Series etc.

**3.1.2** Current or Previous Season is defined by the following:

**3.1.3** To be deemed 'financial', the player must have no outstanding competition/ registration fees within the Affiliated Association or with QTF.

**3.1.4** If a player meets the eligibility criteria for more than 1 Affiliated Association or has changed their principal place of residence after 31 December of the Year prior to the Junior State Cup – the player can choose which Affiliated Association to play for.

**Note:**

The player may not nominate for selection at the same time within two affiliates and can only nominate for selection in the second affiliate if they have been unsuccessful in the original affiliate.







<b>3.1.5</b>	A player is strongly encouraged to play for their Affiliated Association (situated within the geographic area of the regional permit boundaries) in which the players principal place of residence is located.
<b>3.1.6</b>	<p><b>Player Pool</b></p> <p>If a player wishes to participate in a QTF event and the affiliate in which they are an active registered financial member of has not nominated a team in the division, they are eligible to play in. the following processes must occur:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. The Affiliate Association must list the player(s) on a Player Pool Nomination Form and submit to QTF prior to the <b>closing date of Wednesday 29 May 2019</b>.</li><li>2. QTF will then verify and advise if a player has been picked up by another Affiliate Association.</li></ol> <p><b>Note:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>&gt; Players will be first made available to affiliates within their region before being made available to the wider group.</li></ul> <p>The player pool process exists to give individuals the opportunity to participate, however with some safeguards.</p> <p>A player(s) nominated by an Affiliated Association cannot be reelected by the Affiliated Association once placed into the player pool. If the player(s) is not selected by any other Affiliate, they remain unattached to any team.</p> <p>Any player(s) wishing to register for the player pool must have their nomination received by the prescribed date for the event in which they wish to participate. When the players nominate for the player pool, they must indicate which age group (division) they are eligible for. All Affiliates/ Teams in the nominated division will be contacted via email to express interest in the player by the prescribed date for the event.</p>
<b>3.1.7</b>	<p>Player Transfer (if no player pool is constructed)</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Player to submit a transfer request to their current Affiliated Association.</li><li>2. Written approval from the player's current Affiliated Association must be sent to QTF acknowledging the players as an active registered and financial member and allowing the temporary transfer to another Affiliated Association for the event.</li><li>3. Written application must be sent to QTF from the potential Affiliated Association wishing to acquire the new player</li></ol> <p><b>Note:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>&gt; The written application to QTF must clearly state the reason for the transfer, details of the player (e.g. Full Name, DOB, Contact Details) and the division.</li></ul>





	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>› The player is to be transferred/ placed into another Affiliate/ Team from within their current region, first and foremost.</li> </ul>
<b>3.1.8</b>	<p><b>Suspended Player</b></p> <p>A player who is serving a current suspension is not eligible to enter a QTF event.</p>
<b>3.1.9</b>	<p><b>Interstate Player</b></p> <p>Who do not meet the above eligibility criteria are not eligible to participate in a QTF event without prior written consent from QTF and/ or are part of an invited team.</p>
<b>3.1.10</b>	<p><b>Consideration Request</b></p> <p>An Association may seek consideration from QTF for a player(s) who has not met the above eligibility criteria. Any such request must be in writing to QTF.</p>
<b>3.1.11</b>	<p>An Association/ Club conducting a competition not registered with QTF is not eligible to enter a QTF event.</p>
<b>Item 3.2 – MATCH OFFICIALS (REFEREES) ELIGIBILITY</b>	
<b>3.2.1</b>	<p>Nominated Referees must be registered and participating with your association for eligibility and insurance purposes, having regularly officiated at your local Affiliated Association in the Current and/or Previous Season.</p>
<b>3.2.2</b>	<p><b>Badge Accreditation</b></p> <p>In order to conduct a quality State Event, all attending Match Officials must hold a TFA Referee Accreditation of Level 1 – 6 and minimum age of 12 years.</p> <p>The following qualifications are applied for Divisions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>› Under 10s/ 12s Divisions – Must be a Level 1 +</li> <li>› Under 14s/ 16s Divisions – Must be a level 2 +</li> <li>› Under 18s Division – Must be a Level 3 + (or Level endorsed for an upgrade)</li> </ul> <p><b>Note:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>› All match officials nominated must be endorsed by their Affiliate Referee Coordinator and/ or Regional Referee Coordinator.</li> <li>› Any written request for dispensation regarding under age referees must be endorsed by the Regional Referee Director and State Referee Panel prior to approval from QTF.</li> </ul>
<b>3.2.3</b>	<p><b>Under Age Referee</b></p> <p>If any Associations nominates a Match Official (Referee) that is under the age of 18 years, they must nominate a guardian (who also meets the WWCC) to accompany the referee. Under no circumstances will QTF appoint a guardian to the said referee.</p>

3.3.1	<p>The following qualifications are required for the 2019 Junior State Cup:</p> <p><b>Coach:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>› U10s/ U12s/ U14s Division: Minimum TFA Coaching Foundation (Level 1) Accreditation.</li> <li>› U16s &amp; U18s Division: Minimum TFA Coaching Foundation (Level 1) Accreditation. Preferred TFA Coaching Talent Coaching Accreditation (This will be the mandatory requirement by 2020 aligned with the FTEM Model).</li> </ul> <p><b>Assistant Coach:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>› All Divisions: TFA Coaching Foundation (Level 1) Accreditation</li> </ul>
3.3.2	<p><b>Play by the Rules – Online Learning</b></p> <p>Accredited Volunteers are also required to complete the following components from the Play by the Rules portal:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>› <b>Child Protection:</b> Affiliate Coordinator/ Coach/ Assistant Coach/ Manager</li> <li>› <b>Harassment &amp; Discrimination:</b> Affiliate Coordinator/Coach/Assistant Coach/Manager</li> <li>› <b>Complaints Handling:</b> Affiliate Coordinator (Tour Leader) only</li> </ul>
3.3.3	<p>All Accredited Volunteers are to supply the required information when completing the Online Registrations link prior to attending the event.</p>
SECTION 4: EVENT SPECIFIC INFORMATION	
Items 4.1 – TEAMS	
4.1.1	<p>To be eligible to enter Team/s in any QTF event, the affiliated association must be financial and compliant with QTF.</p> <p>Other Teams may be eligible to participate in a QTF event upon written request and approval of QTF.</p>
4.1.2	<p><b>Team Nominations Acceptance</b></p> <p>Will be subject to the required Match Official (Referee) quote being met.</p> <p>No responsibility will be taken for a Team Manager who do not read relevant Conditions of Entry and other event documents.</p> <p>Team nominations received after the relevant closing date will only be accepted at the convenience of the event.</p>
4.1.3	<p><b>Maximum number of Teams</b></p> <p>An affiliate can nominate up to two (2) team per division.</p>





	<p>An affiliate can request to nomination a third team for a division, however this will only be accepted at the suitability of the event.</p> <p>This request must be in writing to the Event Manager by <b>05:00 PM Wednesday 24 April 2019</b>.</p> <p>Affiliated Associations may normally only enter up to two (2) teams per division. If additional team are entered, the stronger of the team will be known as Team A and other(s) known as Team B/ C etc. This will be determined by QTF.</p>
<b>4.1.4</b>	<p><b>Team Numbers</b></p> <p>U10s Division: <u>Maximum of 12 registered players</u> only</p> <p>U12s/ U14s/ U16s/ U18s Divisions: <u>Maximum of 14 registered players</u> only</p>
<b>Items 4.2 - DIVISIONS</b>	
<b>4.2.1</b>	<p><b>Minimum Number</b></p> <p>A minimum of five (5) teams are required to deem a division viable. If there are four (4) or less teams nominated, then those teams will be invited to join with the next closest division a determined by QTF.</p> <p>If sufficient numbers nominated for the division to go ahead at the close of nominations but teams pull out after this time (meaning less than four team are scheduled to participate), the vision will continue in a modified format or will be combined as determined by QTF.</p>
<b>Items 4.3 – FINALS ELIGIBILITY</b>	
<b>4.3.1</b>	<p>A player must have played a minimum of one (1) round game to be eligible for the final series.</p> <p>Any player/s not fulfilling the criteria due to extenuating circumstances must make written application to the Event Manager for consideration.</p>
<b>Items 4.4 – DRAW FORMULA</b>	
<b>4.4.1</b>	<p>After the close o nominations, an indicative draw will be distributed.</p> <p>The draft draw will only be distributed after team lists have been submitted and all nomination fees have been paid with required referee quotas achieved.</p>
<b>4.4.2</b>	<p><b>QTF Draw Format</b></p> <p>The final format will not be finalized until all team nominations are received, however QTF will where appropriate endeavor to have n extended finals series that provides for quarter finals or a similar system and reserved the right to amend the draw the format from time to time when required.</p> <p>QTF will endeavor to follow the below format:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>&gt; Preliminary Games – Round Robin format where possible</li> </ul>

<b>4.4.3</b>	<p><b>Finals Series Positions</b></p> <p>Will be determined as follows</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>› Highest on Ladder – if equal;</li> <li>› Difference (For and Against) – if equal;</li> <li>› Percentage – if equal;</li> <li>› Result of Round Game – if draw;</li> <li>› Drop Off</li> </ul> <p>Refer to 6.8 to the <a href="#">QTF General Conditions of Entry</a> for more information</p>
<b>4.4.4</b>	<p><b>Final Draw</b></p> <p>Will be distributed once all Teams and Match Official registrations are closes and Draw Formats confirmed. This will be distributed to all Affiliate Coordinators/ Team Contacts and made available via <a href="http://www.qldtouch.com.au">www.qldtouch.com.au</a> as soon as possible.</p>
<b>Items 4.5 – PLAYING TIMES</b>	
<b>4.5.1</b>	<p>All games in the event will be 14 minutes each way with a two minute half time break, and five minutes between games.</p> <p>Tournament management reserves the right to alter duration of games based on any specific requirement and in the best interests of completing the event with maximum participation.</p> <p><b>Under 10s Division</b></p> <p>All divisions are to comprise of six (6) a side expect the Under 10s division, which will be five (5) a side on the field at any one time.</p> <p>The following amended rules apply to the Under 10 years division only:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>› <b>Field Size</b> – The playing field size is to be 50m x 35m</li> <li>› <b>Team Composition</b> – 5 players must be on the field at all times. A maximum of 12 players per team is permitted.</li> <li>› <b>Acting half</b> – the acting half cannot run with the ball they must pass the ball off.</li> <li>› <b>Defense</b> – the defense cannot move up until the first receive has received the ball.</li> </ul>
<b>4.5.2</b>	<p>All finals games will result in an outright winner. In the event of a drawn match at the end of full-time, a drop off will determine the match winner.</p>
<b>4.5.3</b>	<p>There is no ‘time off’ for serious injury during any Round Matches or Finals.</p>

4.6.1	In this competition players are unable to move between divisions nor change teams within any Affiliate.
