2025 STATE OF ORIGIN TEAM MANAGER - APPOINTMENT GUIDELINES

1. PURPOSE

- 1.1. The purpose of these guidelines is to ensure a fair and equitable process for the appointment of Queensland State of Origin (SOO) Team Managers in all divisions.
- 1.2. The focus for all appointments shall be the integrity of the Qld Representative Program and its associated objectives.
- 1.3. All intending Managers need to understand that their appointment shall be made in the interests of the Qld Representative Program and as such they may be required to be a Manager in a division other than their preference.

2. REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS

2.1. A TFA Coaching accreditation is not a mandatory requirement to be a Queensland State of Origin Team Managers.

3. APPOINTMENT ROLE & RESPONSIBILITIES

- 3.1. Team Managers will, at all times, be under the direction of the Head Coach and the QTF S00 Program Manager.
- 3.2. Team Managers will be required to fulfil all responsibilities as outlined in the SOO Team Managers – Role Description & Responsibilities document.
- 3.3. Team Managers will be appointed for the 2025 SOO series only.

4. PROCESS

- 4.1. QTF will open online Expression of Interest Queensland SOO Team Manager applications on **Wednesday 1 May 2024.**
- 4.2. Applicants for Team Manager positions are required to have completed the on-line Expression of Interest by **Sunday 19 May 2024**.
- 4.3. The QTF SOO Program Manager will be responsible for coordinating the appointment of Head Coaches, Assistant Coaches and Managers for all teams.
- 4.4. On endorsement by the QTF Board, Team Managers will be advised of their appointment during the week of **Monday 3 June 2024**.
- 4.5. Team Managers must accept the online SOO Team Manager Agreement by **Monday 10 June 2024**.
- 4.6. Queensland State of Origin Appointments for all teams will be advertised on the QTF website and Socials during the week ending **Friday 14 June 2024.**

5. SELECTION CRITERIA & APPOINTMENT

- 5.1. Applicants may be required for interview if candidates cannot be separated.
- 5.2. Primarily, Team Managers shall be appointed on the basis of their
 - 5.2.1. Demonstrated ability to provide leadership to the Queensland Representative program in the relevant division.
 - 5.2.2. Current Team Management record at the Elite level.
 - 5.2.3. Relevant Coaching accreditation status.
 - 5.2.4. Cultural and values in line with Queensland Touch Football.





5.3. Final selections will be made by QTF at its absolute discretion and QTF may consider whatever information in respect of each candidate as they may consider relevant. The exercise by QTF of its discretion shall not be subject to any subsequent review.

6. REPORTING

- 6.1. Team Managers will be required to complete a SOO campaign review at the conclusion of the event.
- 6.2. Team Managers will also be required to undertake a Performance Review at the conclusion of the event and as such will be subject to on-going evaluation.
