Standards of Behaviour.

Participation in the Q Youth Academy (QYA) is a privilege and an opportunity to develop as both a player and a representative of Queensland Touch Football (QTF). All participants are expected to uphold the highest standards of conduct throughout the program. By attending the QYA, you agree to the following expectations:

1. General Conduct

- Participants must always behave respectfully and responsibly, both on and off the field.
- You represent your affiliate, region, permit, and QTF; your actions should reflect this responsibility.

2. Team and Staff Interaction

- Follow all instructions provided by QTF-appointed personnel, including coaches, and venue staff.
- Respond positively to coaching and feedback regarding performance and behaviour.
- Adhere to all team and camp rules as communicated by staff.

3. Uniform and Equipment

- Wear the designated team uniform correctly when required.
- Take care of all issued items; ensure personal belongings are clearly labeled.

4. Movement and Supervision

- Remain within designated areas unless given explicit permission by team officials.
- Do not leave the camp venue without supervision, even if accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Never leave with unknown individuals.

5. Health and Safety

- Report all injuries or health concerns, no matter how minor, to team officials immediately.
- Follow all safety protocols and instructions provided by staff.

6. Digital and Social Media Use

- Electronic devices are permitted but must be stored securely. QTF is not liable for loss or damage.
- Inappropriate use of devices may result in confiscation.
- Use social media responsibly. Do not post images or content involving others without their consent.
- All online activity should reflect positively on yourself, your team, QTF, and Touch Football Australia.

7. Respect and Inclusion

- Treat all participants, staff, and officials with respect and kindness.
- Bullying, harassment, or discrimination of any kind will not be tolerated.
- Communicate thoughtfully. Before speaking, consider:
- THINK – Is it True, Helpful, Inspiring, Necessary, Kind?

8. Compliance and Consequences

- Participants must comply with the [Queensland Touch Football Code of Conduct](#).
- Breaches of behaviour expectations may result in disciplinary action, including but not limited to:
 - Temporary removal from activities.
 - Confiscation of personal items
 - Changes to room arrangements.
 - Dismissal from the program

Should QTF determine that the breach/s made by any participant is significant, the participant will be sent home from the program at parents' full expense.
